#### Question: Explain conception of professionalism?

**Answer**: Professionalism is a way of life which provides a livelihood through the practice of a skill valued by society. This requires a cognitive base of expert knowledge which can be acquired only through protected training in a special field.

# Question: How morality contributes toward the characteristics of profession?
